In 1896 three Salvationists went to Kenya to work on the building of a new railway and made their witness while based at the Taru Camp. The first official meetings were held in Nairobi in April 1921, led by Lieut-Colonel and Mrs James Allister Smith. The first cadets were trained in 1923. On 1 March 2008, the Kenya Territory was divided into two and the Kenya East Territory and Kenya West Territory were created.

WHEN Chief of the Staff Commissioner Robin Dunster dedicated to God the new territorial headquarters building for Kenya East (8 May 2008) she not only opened a new facility but also formally inaugurated the work of a new territory.

The establishment of the Kenya East and Kenya West Territories on 1 March 2008 was directly attributable to the growth of The Salvation Army in this part of the world. Since 2006, an average of one corps per week has been opened in Kenya, each of which has at least 150 worshipping members each week, its own facilities, and the financial ability to support officers.

This pattern of dynamic growth in turn reflects the dedicated service and effective evangelism of thousands of Salvationists across the country.

Under the theme 'New Beginnings',

Commissioner Hezekiel Anzeze (TC) challenged the territory to add 5,000 soldiers and junior soldiers to its ranks within a year, and plans were laid to achieve that goal.
