CALL TO PRAYER

29 SEPTEMBER - 1 OCTOBER

The General, the Chief of the Staff and the World President of Women's Ministries call the worldwide Salvation Army to a weekend of prayer for the victims of sex trade trafficking. The dates, 29 September - 1 October have been chosen by the USA National Headquarters (Liaison Against Sexual Trafficking) with the Canada and Bermuda Territory. Material will be available on their websites. On the Friday, Salvationists and Christian friends are asked to raise the topic of sex trade trafficking with work colleagues, sharing

their concerns and prayers. Saturday and Sunday are dedicated to personal and corporate prayer. Some may also wish to fast. Territories and commands are encouraged to develop their own awareness campaigns amongst their people. For example, the United Kingdom Territory, with the Republic of Ireland is using the theme 'Move it. Speak it. Pray it. Stop it.'
